5. [Know what to do at the scene of an accident.](#)

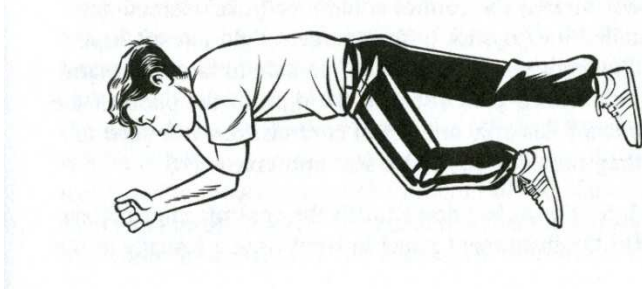
There are 5 key actions. Write them down and write down what or how you would carry them out.
