So you're ready to be a Beaver Scout?

Quickstart guide

Here's what you need to do or know:

1. Uniform

- Buy a turquoise Beaver Scout uniform top (sweatshirt type). These are available from most school outfitters.

You need the turquoise/blue sweatshirt-type top with the  logo on the right sleeve. Badges go on this top only. There are many other available items – but you don't need those yet.

We'd be pleased if you can buy official uniform blue activity trousers – but these can be expensive and are outgrown quickly – so we don't absolutely insist. School uniform trousers are a perfectly acceptable alternative for Parades and other formal occasions.

2. Promise & Law

- You need to be ready to take your Promise:

The Beaver Scout Promise

I promise to do my best
To be kind and helpful
And to love God.

OR

The Beaver Scout Promise

I promise to do my best
To be kind and helpful
And to love Allah.

The Beaver Scout Law

There is no formal Beaver Scout Law. The concepts expressed in the Scout Law are presented to Beaver Scouts through games, storytelling and other informal activities.

3. Payments

- You need to pay a £10.00 Investiture Fee.

Cash or Cheque (to 3rd Whitton Scout Group). This covers registration and includes a Group Scarf, woggle and all badges. You need pay nothing more until the beginning of the next Term, where there is a Membership Fee of £20.00 per (school) Term thereafter.

4. Investiture

- A short ceremony where you repeat your Promise.

This is where you officially join the other 28 million Scouts worldwide. Families are encouraged to watch and take photos of this important milestone in your Scouting career. Arrange your Investiture date now!
